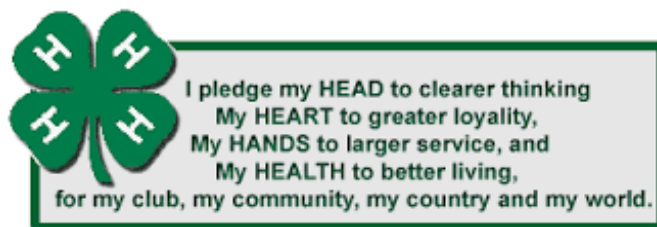


# WHAT'S NEXT
